Gained insight into the process of promoting and launching typefaces.

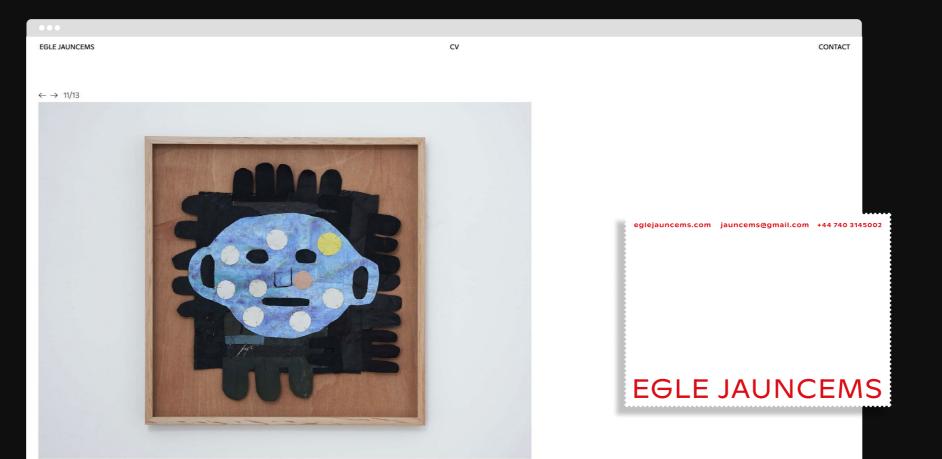

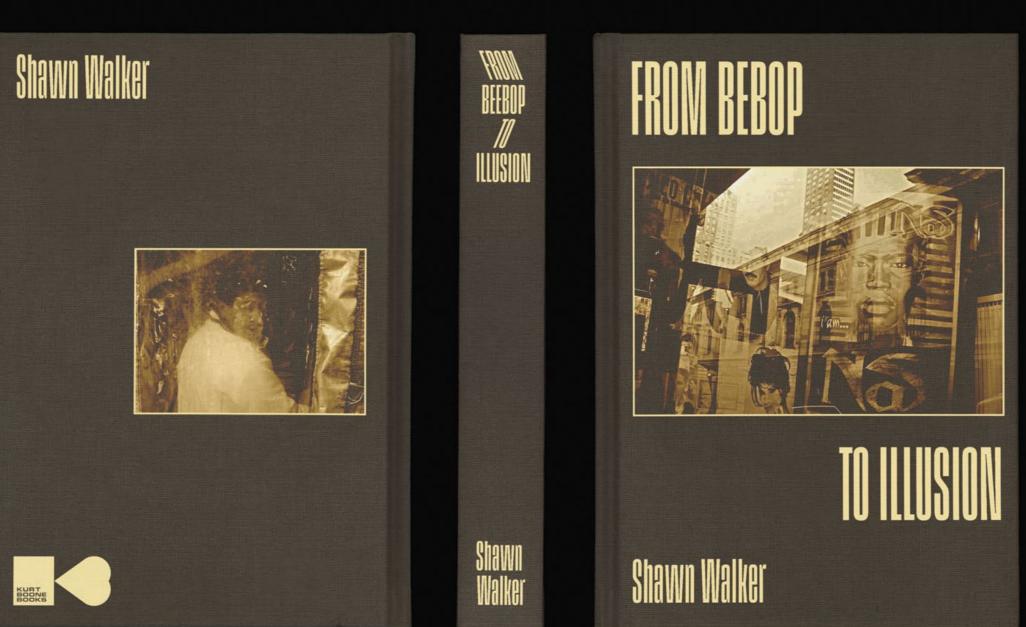

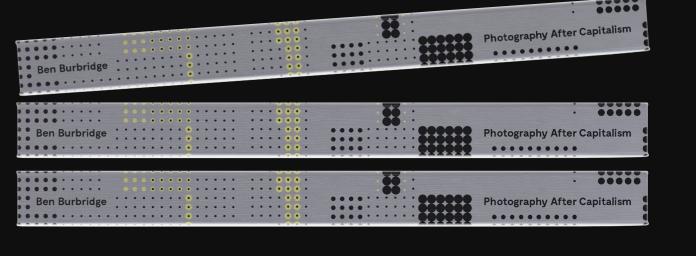
